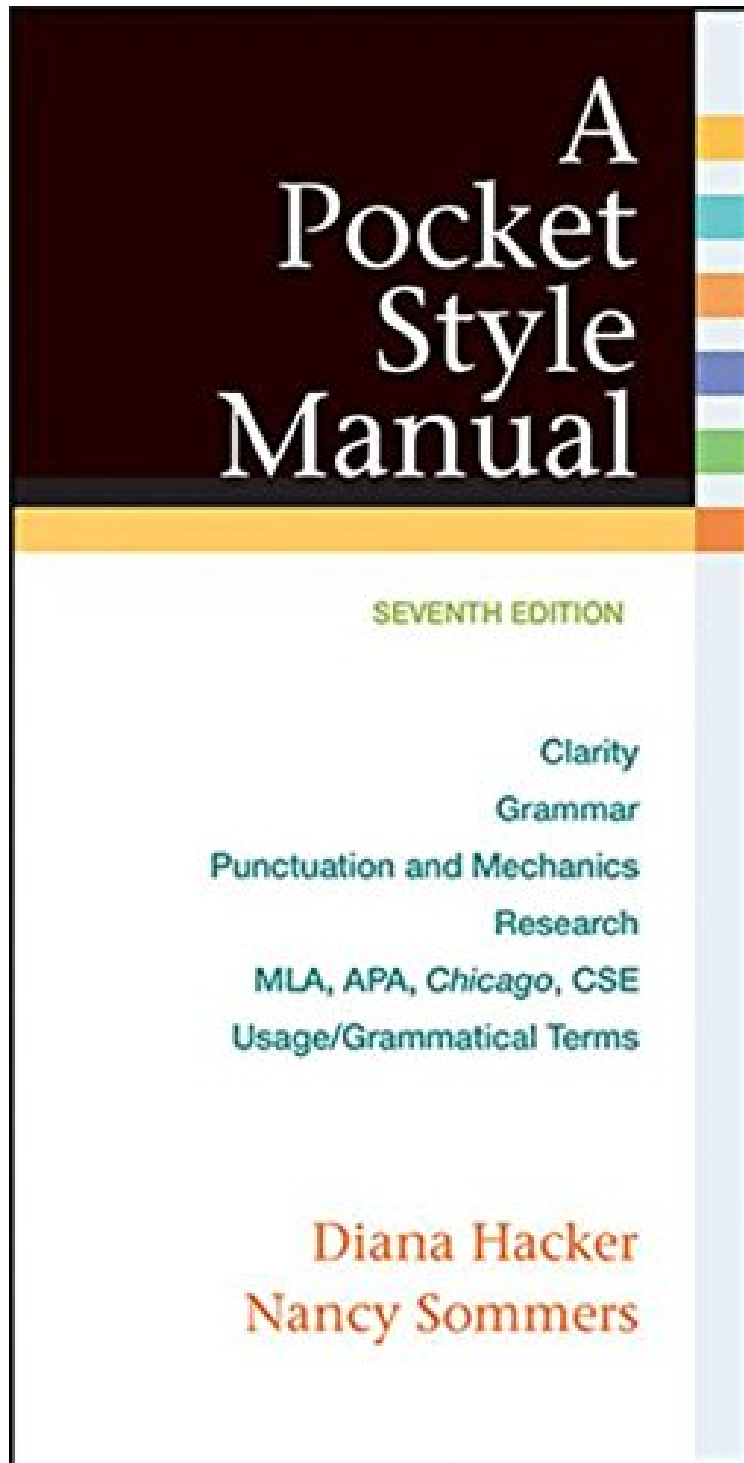

The table of contents is fantastic as are the appendices and indexes. I have also purchased an online version of this book from another provider, as I have felt that this book's instructions are very adequate and without question an authority on the matter of proper format and grammar in English. It indeed comes with instrucionts for proper APA, MLA, Chicago and CSE formats. I would recommend this book, but I would also like to see the pages get thicker and the book's height and width get smaller.
