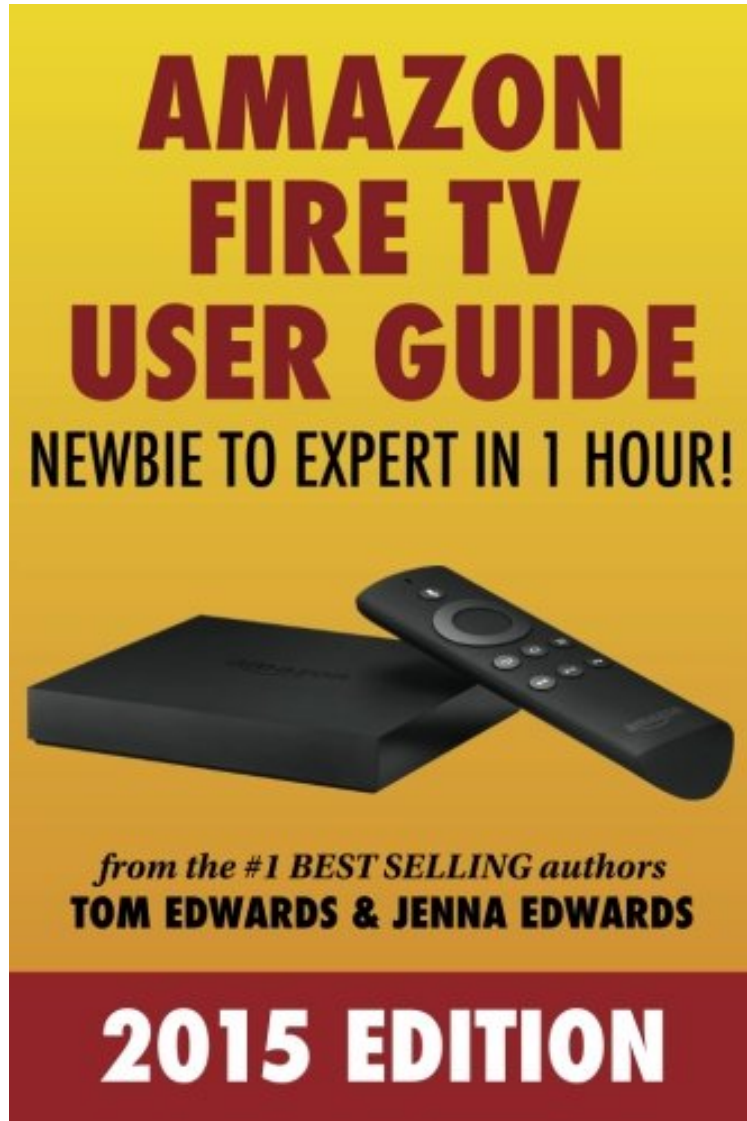

That is, you get the same pep talk in multiple chapters ad nauseum. Though a 2015 edition, it advises subscribing to Netflix before the 2014 rate increase. I have to wonder if the editors know how to read a calendar. While discussing the downloadable apps, it lists a number of apps that are free to download. All is well except that downloading an app for free is not the same as trying to use it for free...many have subscription fees once you get the \*free\* app. That aspect is not well discussed. It covers all of the common questions plus some that are well-beyond the average expertise in less than seventy-five pages. But even the advanced information is "marked" as such. For example, I have one of the very first flat-screen TVs in my kitchen, a small, 18" without an HDMI hook-up. I thought I would connect the Fire TV there to watch while I was cooking. However, the unit requires a bit newer TV, so I had to switch it out with the TV in my guest room.
