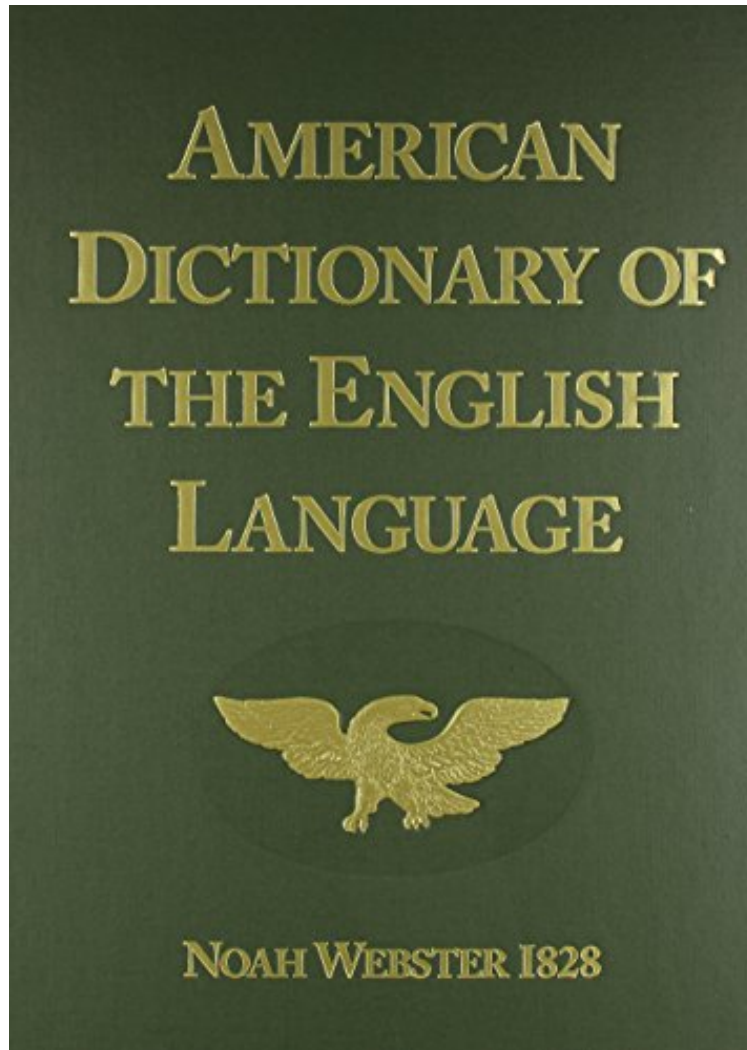

After reading some of the reviews, I had some reservations about purchasing it due to questions of formatting. However, the formatting is more than adequate for a Kindle Dictionary. Rather than swiping through each letter to find your word, there are blocks of letters, and

swiping within the blocks will quickly find your word. Example: Ace--Aor.
