None of these books show any artistry in the construction of the flowers - they're literally just 'use this stitch in roughly that direction to make a ". And yes, they include some of the basic instructions, which can be helpful. But the meat of the

book is missing. This is a coloring book for ribbon embroiderers. I was looking for more. So, while ok, I wasn't completely thrilled with them.
