Over 10,000 manufacturers concoct and distill Baijiu in earthenware jars or pits, sometimes from century-old recipes with mixtures of bacteria and yeast. Made from a variety of grains from sorghum, barley, wheat, and rice, the taste of baijiu range from delicate floral scented gin-like drinks to harsh and fiery alcoholic drinks used to warm farmers and soldiers in the cold. This book is the best guide to the main types of baijiu in China, describing many brands, how they are made, and what they are famous for. The catalog is remarkably extensive and detailed.
