Miller's presentation--simple language, clear explanations, practice work to reinforce--is a perfect fit for my learning style. At the end, I had built a solid foundation and purchased additional non-Miller books to continue my studies.Other reviewers have expressed disappointment. They may have been anticipating a book with a more holistic approach. Princeton Review, Kaplan, etc., do a great job of this--teaching test-taking strategies, teaching math, giving plenty of former GMAT practice questions, etc. They aim for an all-in-one solution. If that's what you're looking for, then Miller's book is not

for you--it is not a standalone resource. This book teaches math concepts for the GMAT, not the GMAT itself. I chose this book as a first step in my study program because I felt the content was better organized than the major titles and because the clarity/teaching style clicked with me. I would recommend it to anyone who (1) may have been away from high school math a while, (2) leans toward thorough preparation, or (3) is a "bottom-up" studier.
