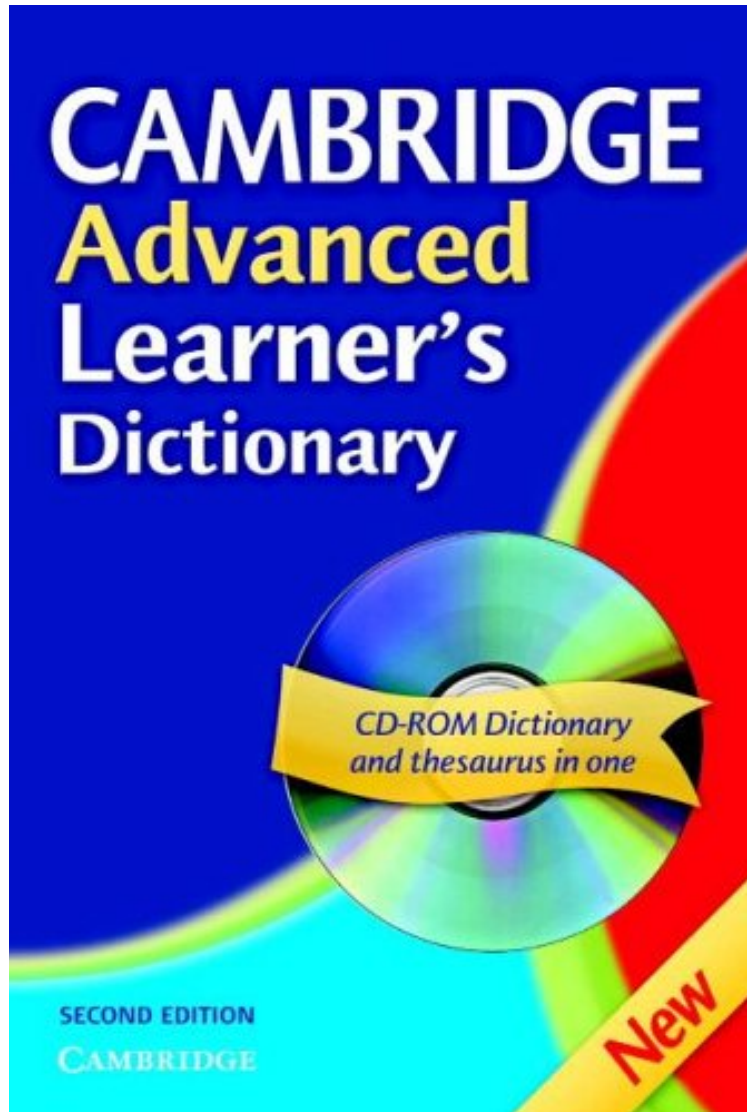

Very useful reference book for ESL students and people who often have errors in English. This 2nd ed. CD has bigger and clearer layout than the previous version. There are a few little annoyances about this CALD2, especially the about accompanied Quick Time Player. It cannot be shutted down and always sticked at the task bar. Also, it takes about a minute and half to start this CALD2. CALD1 is much faster to run. Well, these do not affect the definitions.
